## The Knowledge of the Incarnation Mystery in the Experience of the Spirit in Saint Maximus the Confessor

## Abstract

The personality and the theology of Saint Maximus the Confessor are very important when someone wants to analyze the Christological dispute. Perhaps he was one of the most conclusive regardind this subject. More exactly, our saint wrote in the 7th century many works against nestorianism and monophysite heresies, stressing why is important to believe that in Christ, the Son of God incarnated, there is only one hypostasis but with two natures and with two wills.
