The Main Reason for the Ecclesiastical Journalism, the Quest, its Starting-points and the Methodological Consequences of this Quest

Abstract

The major goal of this communication is not to talk exclusively about the specifics of the internet, but about the internet integrated in the bigger field of ecclesiastical journalism, for the main question from an orthodox standpoint is not finally about the form of journalism but about the content of it. Of course the internet itself has some particular notes, not so easy to accept and promote through an orthodox perspective, but the problems raised by the internet are not more difficult than the ones raised, for example, by the television, among other forms of ecclesiastical journalism.

I did not say that the words in ecclesiastical journalism must be assembled only by the holy persons. What I wanted to set forth is that the personal participation of the sender of the text to the Realities described in that text is very necessary, even if this comprises just basic attempts. Different degrees are possible in this becoming process. Besides this, another inner state is also important to exist and to happen: the dearly wishing after those Realities, to be lively realities of his own existence.

In this communication I have just tried to sketch some aspects regarding the manner in which the orthodox word proposed in the journalistic forms today (audio, television, classical writing or internet) could become more real and to create new personal realities and (why not?) social realities.
