The Demographics Sources of Parish and Suburb "St. Archangels" from Craiova from Organic Regulation up to the Reforms of Al. I. Cuza (1832-1865)

As it appears from the Organic Regulation adopted by the Public Assembly of the Romanian Country after the peace of Adrianople in 1829 signed between Russia and the Ottoman Empire, the civil records were to be made by priests in the churches towns and villages.

They have been and still to be a major historical source that allows to the researchers to identify the compilation of genealogy of ancestry of national and local personalities.

The records allow us to analyze local and overall of the entire city the social composition of those mentioned as baptismal, marriage or death, possibly the existence of minorities, the natural growth, and the effects of the contagious diseases especially on newborns, the average of lifespan, and the kinship links.

The Civil records allow the identification along the time of the descendants of the founders of the original church and the charity acts of some parishioner manifested by assuming the duties of godparents at baptisms and weddings given that this quality involved multiple obligations of the spiritual Parents, so It was well established by baptisms and weddings.
