Commemoration of Andrei Buzdug (1891-1939) from the Theological Academy of Cluj-Napoca Eight Decades after He Passed to his Heavenly Home

Abstract

The commemoration of personalities that have marked a field is a noble duty. Andrei Buzdug, the first rector of the Theological Academy of Cluj-Napoca was a remarkable personality of interwar Cluj. We have tried to add data and documents extracted from the Archives of the Archdiocese and of the old Academy, some novel, to what has been written so far. Besides mending some historical and chronological errors, we have made a short analysis of the obituaries written by the professor from Cluj, unique as subject, emphasising in particular three of them.
