Slavonic Inscription on Lead Sheet from Braşov - the First Metal Writing in Romanian Slavonic

Abstract

This paper presents the Slavonic inscription on the lead sheets from Braşov with the transliteration of the Cyrillic text, the translation into Romanian and the analysis of the text from a philological and epigraphic point of view. The content of the text states that Easter incense is a means of fighting the forces of evil, but man needs faith to avoid the temptation of betrayal like Judas, who will bear the cross of suffering and receive the help of the saints as an effect of faith. of the angels in the face of the devil. From the researches it is found that it is the first semi-official writing from the Slavo-Romanian texts and also on metal, dating from the second half of the 12th century.
